This class is designed to help develop the skills of Scouts to teach all the Outdoor Ethics skills and information needed to pass the requirements for rank advancement and to qualify to serve as the units in this position of responsibility that counts towards Eagle advancement. This course focuses on the participant, while teaching them techniques and providing them with tools to teach Leave No Trace and Tread Lightly! Principles as they apply to the Outdoor Code and Scout Oath and Law. This is a youth only training with an Advisor training scheduled later.
